Regulamento para seleção dos vídeos portugueses a concurso

Cada candidato, deverá submeter vídeo(s) de ecografia com a duração máxima de 3 minutos, com descrição da anatomia (normal ou com patologia) de um dos seguintes 12 locais anatómicos pélvicos:

- 1 Bexiga e ureteres
- 2 Retroperitoneu
- 3 Colo uterino e paracervix
- 4 Ligamentos uterossagrados
- 5 Útero (endométrio)
- 6 Útero (miométrio)
- 7 Trompas
- 8 Ovário
- 9 Orgãos não ginecológicos
- 10 Reto
- 11 Pavimento pélvico
- 12 Vascularização pélvica

Os vídeos, realizados de acordo com as normas definidas pela organização internacional do concurso (ver regras no documento conjunto) deverão ser enviados para o email nucleo.ecografia.spg@gmail.com até ao dia 15 de Outubro de 2022.

Será da responsabilidade do Núcleo de Ecografia, a seleção final dos melhores 24 vídeos. Posteriormente, serão colocados na plataforma e submetidos a concurso internacional (o nome e a foto do ginecologista autor do vídeo serão apresentados na plataforma, juntamente com o seu vídeo), no 2º evento "Ultrasound Pelvic Anatomy - Marathon For solidarity" a decorrer virtualmente a 14 de novembro de 2022, na Università Cattolica del Sacro Cuore of Rome.

"12 Pelvic Sites Contest" - REGULATION -

THE IDEA

To realize a collection of representative video-clips on the ultrasound assessment of the female pelvis.

Twelve pelvic sites have been selected to obtain a comprehensive anatomy description. Ultrasound examiners, members of Scientific National Societies, will contribute to the construction of this unique world database.

The project was launched during the online pelvic ultrasound course organized on May 14th 2022 at the Università Cattolica del Sacro Cuore of Rome and will be presented during the second online event which will take place on November 14th 2022.

WHAT DO YOU NEED TO KNOW TO TAKE PART IN THIS PROJECT?

- 1. Are you a member of a Scientific Society of gynaecologists?
- 2. Check if your Society is already involved in the project "12 Pelvic Sites Contest"
- 3. If not, you could present it to the Board (you can see the "Letter to Scientific Societies") inviting the Society to take part into the project.
- 4. Before the "second event" planned for November 14th the Society could select the best 24 ultrasound videos from the members of their society to upload into the platform.
- 5. During the second event a world database with the videos uploaded by the Scientific Societies from all around the world will be available for all the registered participants.

Three videos with the best quality will be selected for an oral presentation during the event on November 14th.

TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS

All videos must have a maximum duration of 3 minutes and must be saved in MOV and MP4 format. The videos must be uploaded to the platform no later than October 31th.

During the online event the selected videos will be presented by the original examiner (3' for ultrasound videoclip and 2' discussion).

EVALUATION CRITERIA

The video-clips will be reviewed by a Jury composed of members of the Faculty. The judging panel will assess the entries according to the following criteria:

- 1) technical appeal of the video (i.e. quality of production)
- 2) ability to communicate scientific concepts
- 3) level of engagement and innovation
